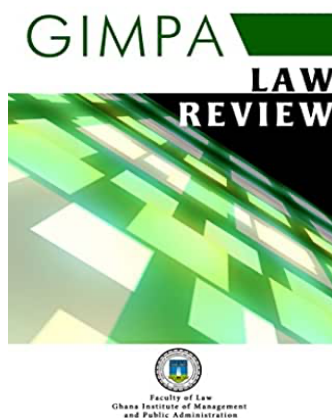

## CALL FOR PAPERS

The GIMPA Law Review is the official journal of the Faculty of Law of the Ghana Institute of Management and Public Administration (GIMPA). Since its initial issue in 2015, the GIMPA Law Review has become one of the most consistent law journals in Ghana, focusing primarily on developments in Ghanaian law. The expertise of the Editorial Board and the Editorial & Publications Committee, as well as the rigorous process for the submission and acceptance of papers, including a mandatory preemption check and double-blind peer review by our many expert anonymous reviewers, is responsible for the GIMPA Law Review becoming a leading source of legal scholarship in Ghana today. There are two issues of the GIMPA Law Review published every year i.e. in January and July.

The Editorial & Publications Committee of the GIMPA Law Review is therefore inviting submissions in the form of Articles, Notes and Comments from legal scholars and practitioners, and academics in various fields, on developments in any area of the law, including critiques of landmark cases and legislation that have shaped and continue to shape Ghanaian law. For the purposes of the GIMPA Law Review, an Article is a full-length paper of between 6,000 and 10,000 words (including footnotes), submitted by a legal professional, practitioner, scholar or expert in a particular field of Law or the Social Sciences that make an original contribution to legal

scholarship. Notes and Comments, on the other hand, are shorter pieces (below 6,000 words), that discuss recent legal developments, with original, cogent and persuasive arguments devoid of extensive citations. Book Reviews of up to 2,000 words are also welcome.

All submissions must conform with the Oxford Standard for the Citation of Legal Authorities (OSCOLA) citation style, which has been adopted by the GIMPA Law Review since its inception [https://www.law.ox.ac.uk/sites/files/oxlaw/oscola\\_4th\\_edn\\_hart\\_2012quickreferenceguide.pdf](https://www.law.ox.ac.uk/sites/files/oxlaw/oscola_4th_edn_hart_2012quickreferenceguide.pdf).

All submissions will also undergo a **mandatory preemption check** and **double-blind peer review** to determine whether they make original contributions to legal scholarship, and are of publishable quality respectively.
